- 1 The Judges decision is final.
- The committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the Showground.
- 3 NO nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- 4 NO entry fee will be refunded.
- 5 The committee reserves the right to amend the schedule and to refuse entries at their discretion.
- Objections to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £50, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 7 Anyone found to be abusive in any form will be excluded from the show ground.
- A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Staffordshire Branch Member in every class, gold armbands must be worn.
- Anyone found mistreating a horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground, and reported to the appropriate body.
- 10 ANY ANIMAL TAKING PART IS LIABLE TO DOPE TESTING
- Any stallions or colts must be led or ridden by an attendant/rider of 14 years old and over. 12 riders must be suitably mounted.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2026.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2025/2026

Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2026 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers will take any necessary precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of persons on the Showground. It is a condition of entry to the Showground that all persons will act on any instructions given to them by the show committee, in so far that it can

affect the health and safety of all. All competitors must take due care to section 7 of the Health and Safety Act and have due regard for the safety of others. There is a Health and Safety Statement on display at the Secretary's Office. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Horses must not be left tied to horse boxes.

Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class (excluding Lead Rein or First Ridden) before 1st September in the current season All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Owners must be Adult / Life Members, Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Annual Members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses Limited before time of entry in order to compete in these classes

Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over.

Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.

The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden.

The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead in July 2026. Qualification will be verified by the office. Only 1st & 2nd prize winners from the Large Breeds, Small Breeds & the Intermediate Section will be eligible for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited Championship. All three sections must be included in the Championship.

- Class 25 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited& Anthony Evans Insurance Brokers Amateur Rider Ridden M&M Mountain and Moorland ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A,B,C,D rider any age.
- Class 26

 UK Ponies & Horses Limited Mini Juniors Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds only, registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over. Riders to have attained their 8th birthday but not their 13th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Combinations would not be required to become a Member of UK Ponies Horses to compete in this class.
- RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance Brokers M&M Small Breeds –
 Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over Registered in their approved Pure
 Breed Society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A
 or B. Rider not to have attained their 14th Birthday before the 1st January
 in the current year.
- Class 28 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance Brokers Intermediate M&M Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Rider not to have attained their 25th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year. (See Rule 7 of the current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Rule Book).
- Class 29 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance M&M Large Breeds Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D. Rider not to have attained their 18th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Championship for the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 27 to 29 ONLY
